If you are in Years 10, 11 or 12 at School and love to dance, this Program is the answer for you.

CUA20113 Certificate II in Dance with selected units of competency from the CUA30113 Certificate III in Dance: a preparatory qualification that allows learners to develop basic technical skills and knowledge to prepare for work in the live performance industry.

Credit in the VCE or VCAL: recognition of up to four VCE VET units at Units 1 and 2 level and a VCE VET Units 3 and 4 sequence. VET Dance will be taken into contribution to your ATAR.

Note: The Units 3 and 4 sequence of VCE VET Dance is not designed as a stand-alone study. Students are strongly advised against undertaking the Units 3 and 4 sequence without first completing Units 1 and 2.

Isolation Performing Arts Studio brings you the highest quality training in your chosen styles of dance. In 2022 we will be offering Jazz, Contemporary, Tap, Street Dance and Classical Ballet (other styles would need to be discussed with the principal before enrolling).

Fee structure:

Course fees are paid monthly via Direct Debit on the first of each month February to November. Inclusive fees also include entry to the Metropolitan Festival of Dance and various performances.

4 hours each week consisting of:

2 hours of technique in chosen style and 2 hours of dedicated VET course work.

Year 1 (Units 1&2): 10 Monthly payments \$240.00 (yearly \$2,400) Year 2 (Units 3&4): 10 Monthly payments \$247.20 (yearly \$2,472)

Total course cost: \$4,872

2 hours each week of dedicated VET course work (with techniques to be taken separately)

Year 1 (Units 1&2): 10 monthly payments \$165.00 (yearly \$1,650) Year 2 (Units 3&4): 10 monthly payments \$170.00 (yearly \$1,700)

Total course cost: \$3,350
